What are important board dates and events?

Monthly Student Board meetings are required and will take place throughout the year on a recurring date and time.

Members will also be asked to attend one Miami Cass REMC Board of Directors meeting to give an update on the student board.

Members can miss no more than three meetings in a year or miss two consecutive meetings with no notification to Miami-Cass REMC staff of valid reason for missing the meeting.

Optional trips or activities may take place throughout the year as decided by the Student Board and Miami-Cass REMC staff.

What are the requirements of the Student Board?

The board will be involved in one community project and one fundraising project per school year along with regular monthly board meetings. Members who are selected for the Student Board as juniors will stay on the board through their senior year as well. All members must participate in the Student Board agreed-upon community service events, activities and projects, and attend the scheduled monthly board meetings. Members will provide a voice for your generation of expectations of electric cooperatives. Members should be present with enthusiasm and a thirst for community and self-improvement. Finally, a parent or guardian must be a Miami-Cass REMC member or employee in good standing.

What do you get as a Student Board Member?

Miami-Cass REMC Student Board Members who meet or exceed all the requirements and responsibilities will earn a logo polo shirt, as well as a \$2000 scholarship for completing two years of service.
